Text: Ephesians 4:1-6

- ❖ Read, meditate on, and pray through Ephesians 4:1-6

Reflect: (Spend time with God thinking about these statements or questions)



Interact: (Discuss the following questions with your group or some friends)

- ❖ How can we bear with one another in love (v.2)?
- ❖ What is the difference between a calling and a job? What does it mean that the Christian life is a calling?
- ❖ Describe the unity that God has given us with other believers (locally or around the world) even when we have differences with them (vv.3-6).
- ❖ What threatens unity in our Christian community?
- ❖ What is the “single hope” that goes with our call?
- ❖ What is the significance of Paul’s continued use of “one”? Can we be followers of God apart from the church? What about the church community is essential for our growing up in Christ?

Apply: (Look for ways to apply at least one concept to your life)

- ❖ We are considering changing the words that represent our *transformation process*. The words are only important in helping us to articulate and practice things that helps grow in maturity. *Restore, Love, and Serve* is our current language. Two passages that I believe are helpful are John 15:1-17 and Micah 6:8. Spend some time in prayer, meditation, and study as we begin to discern together the ways God is seeking to disciple us. Look for the things God does and look what he requires of us. Spend some moments each time you are gathered to pray and discuss this.
